## Verona Community Center Report

The Center continues to serve the needs of the community as a gathering place for meetings, parties and other activities. Guests to the no-pay internet café are increasing to use laptops and Wi-Fi. We are pleased to have served 30,167 guests and 1,034 events since our opening in March 2016. We are booking more events, particularly on weekends, and are seeking volunteers who can help on weekends and evenings, as well as fill in during summer vacation time.

**The showers are operational** and have been used 61 times to date. The laundry has been used 44 times. We are looking into sound treatments in the café area and hallways to alleviate noise issues particularly when there are multiple events. We held a fundraising dance on Friday with the Boogie Kings and proceeds of \$425 benefit operations of the center.

A team with Mission Madness from Hampton did painting and cleaning of the center recently, and we have had two community service workers helping with cleaning and set up several days a week. We are filling a unique need in our community through this outreach program. Thanks to each

of you for your continued prayers and support for the center and our dedicated volunteers who serve.

#### **5 PRACTICES OF FRUITFUL CHURCHES:**

I have been so proud to be your pastor for these past few years and to see how much we have been able to show God's love to our community and the world. We have been able to take part in almost a dozen mission trips, providing disaster relief for victims in Florida and West Virginia, improving the lives of the Cherokee people in North Carolina, taking youth to Pennsylvania, Ohio, Delaware, and as far as the Dominican Republic.

The last few months have seen us successfully coming together to take over and renovate the trailer (owned by Verona UMC) with the intention of providing a temporary home for someone in need. We have had three amazing and full Easters with big church family celebrations, and Christmas services filled with little sheep and laughter while celebrating Jesus. We had some hard and open discussions in the aftermath of Charlottesville, where we looked each other in the eyes on Sunday and showed once again how we are a church who does things differently. We celebrated two traditional Seder dinners, and experienced its significance together. We did free lunches of hot dogs, chips, and soda in the summers and had a softball team in the spring. And that's just the big events- phew!

But you all partnered with me in smaller, consistent ways too, week after week. You shared your thoughts on God and my sermons in real time, asking thought-provoking questions which helped a lot of us (especially me) grow in my understanding of Christ. Some of you showed up every week to our Wednesday night LifeGroup and shared your joys, doubts, and everyday struggles. And others came regularly to our Ladies Night events where you got to laugh, fellowship, and create a beautiful craft. We all got together every month for a potluck where we simply shared our lives and our food together as a community. My hope for you all is that Aisle 7 continues doing the things that made us a welcoming place for people to come and share in fellowship. 
